As per LCI constitution, DG, VDGs, IPDG, all PDGs, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer and all current Zone Chairpersons were invited to attend the meeting. After the meeting, Lion Elvio's name, together with a full set of required documentation were forwarded to LCI and the International Board of Directors subsequently made a decision on approving the appointment.

My warmest congratulations to Lions Elvio and Gae. I am fully confident that Elvio, in conjunction with his Cabinet team and our dedicated clubs, will steer Lionism to even greater heights in the coming Lions Year.

My heartfelt thanks to Lion CC/IPDG Warren Latham for convening and chairing the Special Meeting and to all the PDGs and Lions leaders who attended the meeting to help bring about this very positive outcome.
